Summer Eclectic competition

This year we will be running a summer eclectic competition over a 10-week window (end June to early September). If successful and popular this may well become a regular addition to our summer calendar.

An eclectic does not entail any additional competitions or rounds to be set up. It is just a case of collecting scores from singles competitions, for those players who have entered, across the weeks when the comp is running.

At the end of the period, we will calculate the best net stroke-play score for each player on each hole and the player with lowest total wins. The committee will keep track of all individual rounds of entrants over the qualifying time-period. This will include all mid-week medals and stablefords played in the Tues and Thurs Seniors slots (including club comps). Scores from knockouts, pairs and match play competitions are excluded.

Rules as follows:

- You must register and pay by June 21 to enter no retrospective or late entries allowed.
- Each golfer plays as many singles rounds as they wish in the time window (to a maximum of 7 counting rounds).
- First counting round will be Tues 25 June and final round will be Sept 5.
- Only singles games played in the Tuesday and Thursday Seniors slots will count.
- At the conclusion of each qualifying round, the tournament committee compares player scores on each hole.
- The lowest net score made on each hole is recorded for the eclectic, producing one 18-hole score at the end of the qualifying window.
- A table will be published periodically indicating the current position of each player in the eclectic.
- At the end we will produce a ranking table and prizes will be awarded to the top 5 players (if entry exceeds 30).
- Entry fee = £5 (via seniors Treasurer)
