


## Seniors' Section

### Spring Tour – Monmouthshire

11 – 13 May 2026



For the Spring 2026 tour we will be based at the Cwrt Blddyn Hotel and Spa. We will play rounds at the Monmouthshire Golf Club, Woodlake Park Golf Club and the Rolls of Monmouth Golf Club.

**Monmouthshire Golf Club:** From almost every point there are outstanding views of wooded countryside and surrounding hills. The highest, Mynydd Pen-y-Fal was given the name Sugar Loaf because it resembled cone-shaped blocks of sugar once imported into the country. To the northeast is the majestic holy mountain Skirrid Fawr, a chapel stood on the summit and in the past a handful of it's soil was placed in coffins or graves. Legend has it that the clefts at each end of the mountain were caused by an earthquake at the time of the crucifixion. They are in fact a result of geological landslips.



Recorded history takes us back to at least the 12th century. The clubhouse stands on or close to the site of Beilu Du mansion once one of the principle houses of the county, here Gwarun Ap Caradwg lived until he was treacherously murdered by William De Braose in Abergavenny Castle, December 1175.

It is believed that the original semi-fortified medieval house was sited to face the Bloreng mountain across a water filled moat.

**Woodlake Park Golf Club:** Laid out on naturally undulating landscape, the course offers a challenge to golfers of all abilities.

Opened in 1993, the course has matured quickly and the quality of both fairways and greens make this one of the finest inland golf courses in Wales.

The greens, including the practice greens, were all constructed to the U.S.Golf Association specifications and are truly one of the major assets of the course. The course has quickly attained a reputation for its overall quality with the greens being renowned for their

trueness and speed. Indeed, Woodlake has hosted many National, County and regional PGA events in its relatively short history.

That other sleek driving machine, Greg Norman, also paused here on his way to the top of world golf. He was attached to The Rolls of Monmouth as Touring Professional in the 1980's. Tony Jacklin often wondered why this majestic course remained a well-kept secret. Astonishingly it is
