Blackwell Golf Club

Six times an Open Championship Regional Qualifying course, Blackwell Golf Club is the quintessential English gem, has a proud history dating back to 1893 and is recognised as one of the best courses in the county.

Founded as a 9 hole course in 1893, the course was extended to 18 holes in 1923 thanks to Tom Simpson & Herbert Fowler who are credited with the layout we enjoy today.

Blackwell is a traditional members club that respects the traditions of the game, is renowned for its hospitality and welcoming environment, and has a golf course consistently regarded as one of England's finest.



Blackwell is an 18 hole, par 70 course. Both loops of 9 start and end within close proximity to the clubhouse. Despite its modest length of 6,248 yards, Blackwell remains a tough challenge owing to its five par 3 holes with well-guarded and intricate green sites. The 12th hole has an unusual feature, with a 200 yard long bunker running the length of the hole.

The course also benefits from tee grounds close to the previous green site, meaning the course is extremely walkable and affords a swift pace of play.
