

AUTUMN TOUR 2026

6th - 8th October

The autumn tour will take place on October 6th, 7th and 8th.

The first course is at Lyme Regis:

Lyme Regis Golf Club was founded in 1893 and is recognised as one of the finest golf courses in the South West. The golf course hosts county, regional and national championships, the 18 hole par 71 course occupies a cliff top site with coastal views towards Portland Bill and overlooks the Historical town and World Heritage Site of Lyme Regis, It is a challenging test, with a sea breeze, ideal for all abilities.

After Lyme Regis we drive to stay at the Mercure Hotel in Exeter.

Day 2 is at the Links course of Dawlish Warren:

Not only is this the only true links course in south Devon – it has been referred to, and with some reason, as the ‘St Andrews of the South’ – but is situated on a narrow peninsula, in truth not much more than a wide spit of land, between the sea and the estuary of the River Exe. The area is an internationally-renowned wildlife conservation area, flat as you might expect, with the usual enemies on a links course, such as narrow fairways, gorse, heather, naturally-occurring bunkers, the odd Sandhill, a none-too-friendly wind and the occasional train. Overnight at The Mercure in Exeter.

Day 3 is at the East Devon course at Budleigh Salterton

Situated on the cliffs above Budleigh Salterton the course is one of the stars on the south Devon coast and one of the best golf courses in Devon. Regularly listed in top 100 golf course lists it combines cliff top views with a fine heathland golf course.
